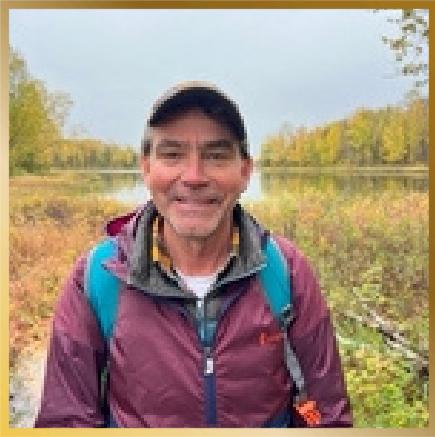

MEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

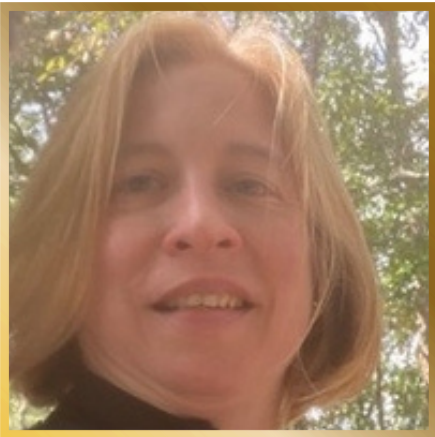
Bradley “Brad” Evans

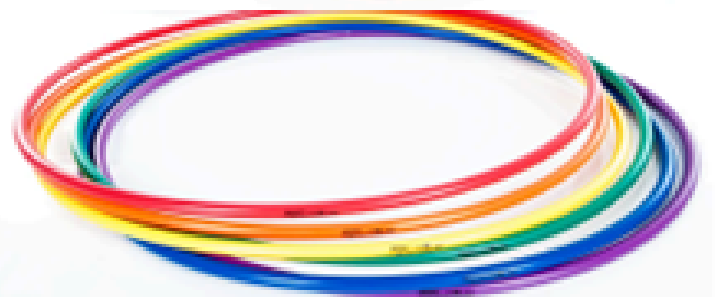

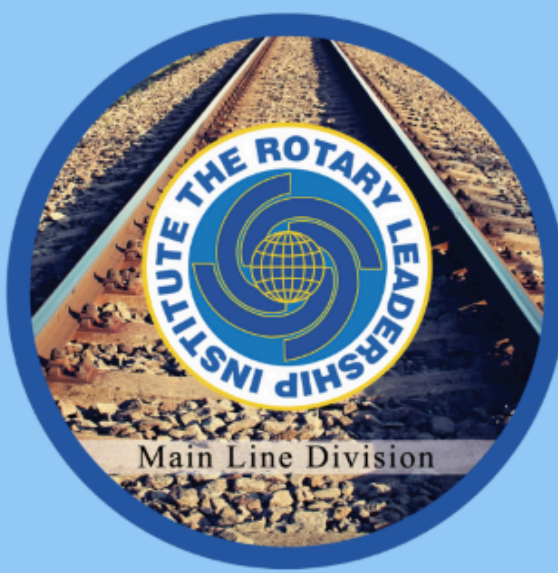

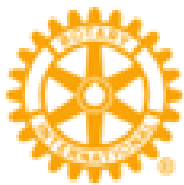
